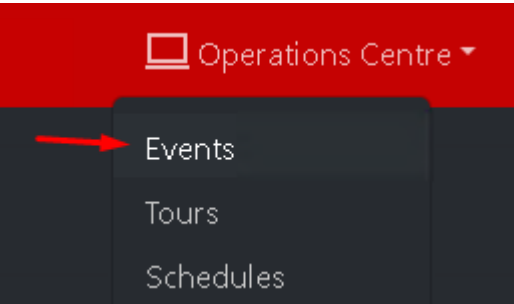

Flying from London Heathrow (EGLL) to Dundee Airport (EGPN) offers pilots a scenic and varied journey. Shortly after takeoff, pilots ascend over the bustling cityscape of London, with iconic landmarks like the Thames River, the Shard, and the London Eye visible on clear days. As the aircraft climbs, the urban sprawl gives way to the picturesque English countryside, characterized by patchwork fields, quaint villages, and winding rivers. The route typically takes the aircraft over the Midlands, where pilots might spot the Peak District's rolling hills and lush greenery.

As the flight progresses northward, the landscape transitions into the rugged beauty of Scotland. Pilots can enjoy views of the Scottish Lowlands, with their expansive forests and lochs. Approaching Dundee, the aircraft descends over the River Tay, offering a stunning view of the Tay Rail Bridge and the city of Dundee nestled along the riverbanks. The final approach to Dundee Airport provides a unique perspective of the surrounding countryside and the North Sea coastline, making for a visually rewarding end to the journey.


Note that Dundee has a pretty short runway, so most airliners will not be able to land here.

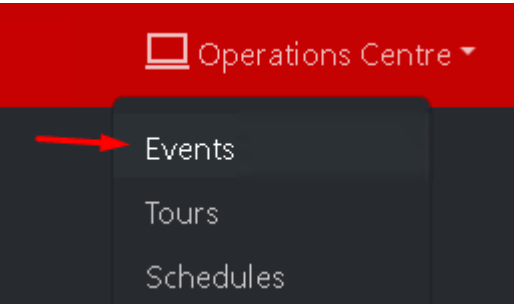
